Mentor

- All young people have the potential to succeed in life and contribute to society. However, not all children get the support they need to thrive.
- By all estimates, 17.6 million young people – nearly half the population of young people between 10 and 18 years of age – live in situations that put them at risk of not living up to their potential.
- Without immediate intervention by caring adults, they could make choices that not only undermine their futures, but, ultimately, the economic and social well-being of our nation.

Time Commitment

- One year
- Spend a minimum of eight hours or a day per month one on one with mentee
- Communicate with mentee weekly
- Attend an initial two hour training session
- Attend optional mentor/mentee group events, mentor support groups and program recognition events
